

Playgroup Lesson: Patience

Aim: To practice patience by turn-taking with others

1. Prayers

2. Songs : “Patience” by Stephan Brown or
“Be Patient” from Enkindle

3. Quote: **“Be patient for Thy Lord is patient”** Baha’u’llah
Whisper this as a group, then whisper from one person to another around the group.

4. Story: “I Just Can’t Wait” (from Enkindle) Use dolls and toys to dramatise the story for the children.

5. Art activities:

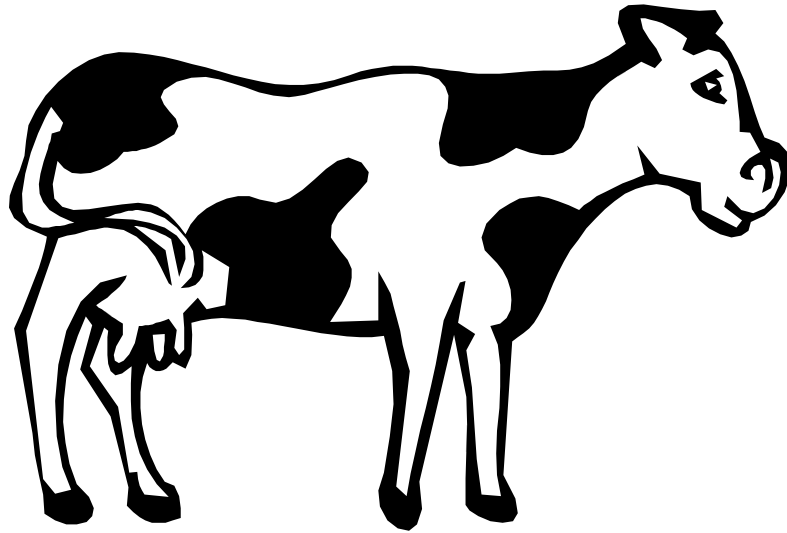
1. Colouring page and quotation
