Give out tea cups to children as we say the quote together.
4. Story: "Feast for Ten"
5. Colouring pages: Quote (1)

 Service collage sheet (3)
6. Activities: Playdough – practice baking and serving others the food (1)

 Water play – practice washing dishes, setting the table, making food, bathing baby dolls and making beds etc

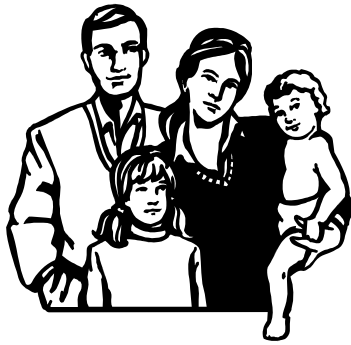
 Icing biscuits – ice biscuits to serve to the other children at the end of class.
